

The Race:

FANS 12 & 24 Hour Races

This event, now in its 24th year, will host a limited field of 150 runners and walkers. Entrants will solicit pledges on a per-mile or flat-rate basis and keep on the move for 12 or 24 hours to support the FANS Scholarship Fund.

FANS is one of the largest 24-hour races in the US, taking place on asphalt, dirt and concrete paths around a classic Minnesota lake. The average high and low temperatures for race weekend are 74° and 54°F; record high 92°F in 1939, record low 37°F in 1946. Sunrise is 5:30 am, sunset 8:53 pm. It's never snowed.

Over 150 volunteers, each putting in at least a 6.5-hour shift, work around-the-clock to provide exceptional support that keeps participants moving from 8:00 a.m. Saturday to 8:00 a.m. Sunday. The results are impressive: usually 15 or more participants run 100 miles and beyond, with the winner generally running over 130 miles.

In addition to the achievements of the participants, \$20,000-\$30,000 is raised each year for the FANS Scholarship Fund. Over the last 23 years, the event has amassed more than \$880,000.

Immediately following the race, all participants and volunteers are invited to a complimentary awards breakfast.

The Cause:

Furthering Achievement through a Network of Support (FANS)

Pillsbury United Communities initiated the FANS project in 1989 with a group of sixth grade students from North and South Minneapolis. The FANS (Furthering Achievement through a Network of Support) Project has a vision of sending inner-city kids to college or other post-secondary educational institution.

FANS works with the youth and their families in a wide variety of activities geared to providing support for this vision. Together, they work for a drug-free and sexually responsible life, a fulfilling educational experience, and involvement in the communities where they live.

To date, 171 FANS students have graduated from high school, over \$700,000 in Post-Secondary Education Scholarships have either been distributed or promised to graduates, and the project has expanded to over 90 students operating out of multiple Pillsbury centers.

Proceeds from the FANS 12 & 24 Hour Races serve as the sole source of funding for the FANS Scholarship Fund

READ & SIGN the RELEASE & WAIVER

No entry will be accepted without signature. This entry contains a release and waiver. Signing it precludes any claim for injury. I know that my participation in the FANS race is a potentially hazardous activity. I understand that I should not participate in this event unless I am properly trained, am in excellent condition, and have no medical conditions, which could worsen with intense physical activity. Knowing these facts, I am entering this event at my own risk and assume all risk and responsibility for injuries I may incur or cause as a direct result of my participation in this event. In consideration of the acceptance of my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, agree not to hold any and all participating sponsors, supporters, race committee members and the board of directors, employees and agents of such parties, or the City of Minneapolis, Minneapolis Park & Recreation Board, Pillsbury United Communities, and the officers and employees of such entities, or any group or individual not identified herein, responsible for any claims. Furthermore, I release and waive the sponsors' representatives and successors from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons named in this waiver. I further grant permission to Pillsbury United Communities to use any photos of myself for promotional opportunities. I verify that I have full knowledge of the risks involved in this event and that I am physically fit and sufficiently trained to participate in it. I acknowledge that race organizers can refuse entry at their discretion.
